Judge Roy Moore to be keynote speaker  
at Hosea 4:6 Ministries Conference

Judge Roy Moore, former chief justice of the Alabama Supreme Court, will be the keynote speaker at the Hosea 4:6 Ministries Call to Action Conference to be held Saturday, Aug. 14, at the Liberty Church Camp F.I.R.E. complex.

Other speakers include Phil Baker, founder and CEO of Hosea 4:6 Ministries with headquarters in Smyrna, Tenn., and Dr. Timothy Baker of Madison, Ala., who will speak on the nation's new health care law.

Moore, author of the book, "So Help Me God," which will be on sale at the conference, is well known throughout Alabama. He served as the state's chief justice from 2000 to 2003. He garnered national attention when he refused to remove a monument depicting the Ten Commandments from the lobby of the Alabama Supreme Court building after a lawsuit was filed by the American Civil Liberties Union. The case went all the way to the United States Supreme Court, and other Alabama justices removed him from office for refusing to obey the final judgment ordering removal of the monument.

A noted constitutional and American history scholar, Moore now serves as president of the Foundation for Moral Law, a non-profit organization that defends individuals and groups fighting First Amendment legal battles among other issues. He also tours the country speaking to churches and other groups about the rule of law and the sovereignty of God.

Holding pastor workshops is one way Moore is trying to educate the Church. The workshops, he says, focus on teaching pastors about the "rule of law and God's sovereign jurisdiction over nations." There is a misconception in America about the relationship between government and God, he says. Those who try to use the New Testament teachings of Jesus to justify America's drifting away from moral and constitutional principles are in error, he believes.

"That's not what Jesus said," Moore insists. "Jesus said to render unto Caesar the things that are Caesar's, and render unto God the things that are God's."

Moore says he is concerned about the church as it relates to American government and our culture. "Basically the church is not doing its role," he says., adding that the church, is supposed to be an overseer of culture and government.

"The role of the church," Moore explains, "is the same role as that of Nathan to David ... to declare the truth." He adds that God's laws are "sovereign over" national law, and "that's historical as well as biblical."

Moore says America has a problem when the president of the United States can sign a proclamation glorifying sodomy, adding that the church and the nation "need to wake up."

Baker says he is overwhelmed that Moore has agreed to speak at the inaugural Call to Action Conference. "When our ministry first learned that securing Judge Moore as keynote speaker was a possibility, I was very excited," he says. "To have someone of his stature taking time from his busy schedule to speak to conference visitors is truly a blessing."

Baker adds that he has long been an admirer of Moore because of his courage and expertise in constitutional issues and in the Christian heritage undergirding America's system of law and government. "I believe everyone who attends the conference will benefit from Judge Moore's knowledge and wisdom," he says.

The Call to Action Conference is open to anyone interested in learning more about America's Christian heritage and how to become involved in efforts to stem the tide of secular humanism rolling across the nation, Baker says.
